
## Casual Professional Minimum Engagement Decision Tree



## Example 1 – One Work Schedule

Rob has a casual work schedule in DUD work between 10am – 12pm and the pm – 5pm. Rob will record 3 hours on their casual timesheet. Because they were not working on an otbetract or work schedule on the day, they will be paid for 6 hours for their casual work.

## Example 2 - Multiple Work Schedules or Contracts

James works as a fixed-term research asstistathe Faculty of SET. They also work as a casual professional in the Faculty of ABLE. ## Example 3 – Multiple Work Schedules /Contracts

Rita will record 1 hour on each of their casual timesheets and setting and setting less than 3 hrs p/dain the location field.
