## Q1 Why is the University smoke-free?

We have a legal responsibility to provide a safe **wockplame**tect staff, students and visitors from the serious health risks associated with exposure to second hand smoke (passive).

The University also encourages healthier lifestylfoclstatife students and the wider community who share and visit our campuses.

A smoke-Free University was introduced after feedbætikevdafsonen members of the University community and consultation with a range of key stakeholders.

#### Q2 When did the University become smoke-free?

The University has been smoke-free at North Terracsin (Cemplus) 2010 with progressive implementation across all campuses by 1 July 2011.

## Q3 Where does the smoke-free initiative apply?

The smoke-free initiative applies to:

- x all campuses, properties, buildings, vehicles or othernedeasntrolled or leased by the University; except where a specific exemption has been granted;
- x all retail vendors operating on Unionalistic, controlled or leased premises.
