

SCHOLARLY TEACHING FELLOWS

Clause 2.4 of the University of Adelaide Enterprise Agreement 2017-2021, outlines the terms and conditions by which Scholarly Teaching Fellows can be appointed. This information sheet provides a summary of key aspects of the clause.

Key Points:

- ❖ Opportunity for early career academics
- ❖ Recognising teaching excellence with continuing positions

The Enterprise Agreement provides that the University will appoint 35 or more academic staff into this category of continuing positions to undertake teaching that would otherwise have been performed by casual academic staff. A casual academic staff member will be appointed as a Scholarly Teaching Fellow at either Level A or Level B through an open and merit based selection process.

Scholarly Teaching Fellows will be paid in a salary range commencing at Level A, step 3 up to a maximum of Level B, step 6, with annual incremental progression where performance is assessed as satisfactory by the University.
