

Information Sheet: Children in the workplace

Purpose

The purpose of this information sheet is to provide information and guidance in relation to children (i.e. those under 18 years of age), in the workplace at the University of Adelaide and to meet the requirements of the <u>University's Health and Safety Policy</u> and <u>Hazard Management Procedure</u>. As part of its business or undertaking, the University has a primary responsibility under the <u>Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA)</u> to take reasonable steps to ensure that the health and safety of any person, including children, is not compromised by the work performed.

Q1 What activities does this information sheet apply to?

This information sheet applies:

to any University-related activity, work, research, teaching where a parent/guardian brings a child into the workplace while they are undertaking a University activity.

The workplace includes:

all of the University-controlled spaces and spaces in which University-related work is being undertaken as part of an off-campus activity.
