2.3 Limitations on the Use of Fixed-Term Contracts

The use of xed-term contracts will be limited to the employment of a sta member engaged in work activity on terms that correspond with one (1) of the employment types described in this section. With the approval their supervisor, a sta member may engage in additional casual work (as de ned in clause 2.1.3) unrelated to, identi ably separate from, their normal duties.

2.3.2 Senior staff cotracts

- 2.3.2.1 A xed-term Senior StaContract may be o end to the following:
 - (a) A person to be appointed as an Area Manager;
 - (b) A person to be appointed as a Head of School or equivalent;
 - (c) Professional states to be appointed at the classication level of Senior Manager or to a position to which a total remuneration package greater than \$260,000 (or part-time equivalent) applies; or
 - (d) Academic sta to be appointed to a position to which a total remuneration package greater than \$260,000 (or part-time equivalent) applies.
- 2.3.2.2 Where a person enters into a Senior Sta Contract, then the terms of this Agreement (other than classical 2.3.2.) will not apply to the employment, except in relation to annual leave, long service leave, perso leave, compassionate leave, family and domestic violence leave, community service leave, public holidays, parental leave, exible work arrangements, concurrent partner leave, academic freedom and salary packaging.
- 2.3.2.3 Consultation about major change will occur in accordance with the model consultation term for sta employed on a SenicstaffContract.
