Cost

All costs associated ith testing and vaccination must be paid for by the definit. The cost of testing and vaccinations vary from provider to provider (ranging from approximate 200\$ \$500). The consultation fee at a GP may be covered by Medicare and the vaccination may be covered by some private health insurance companies. Stents are advised to consult their private health insurance provider regarding associated costs with vaccines.
