Cost

All costs associated with testing and vaccination must be paid for by the student. The cost of testing and vaccinations vary from provider to provider (ranging from approximately \$200 to \$500). The consultation fee at a GP may be covered by Medicare and the vaccination may be covered by some private health insurance companies. Students are advised to consult their private health insurance provider regarding associated costs with vaccines.

Preferred Providers
