

Introduction

ORCiD stands for Open Researcher and Contributor ID. It is a persistent digital identifier that distinguishes you from every other researcher, throughout your career.

The University requires current and new Academic staff and Higher Degree by Research students to obtain an ID for linking to various University research systemsⁱ, and to better capture an overview of your growing research output.

Follow this guide to sync your existing ORCiD with University of Adelaide figshare. If they are linked, metadata datasets and some other item types published on figshare will be published to your ORCiD profile.

Procedure

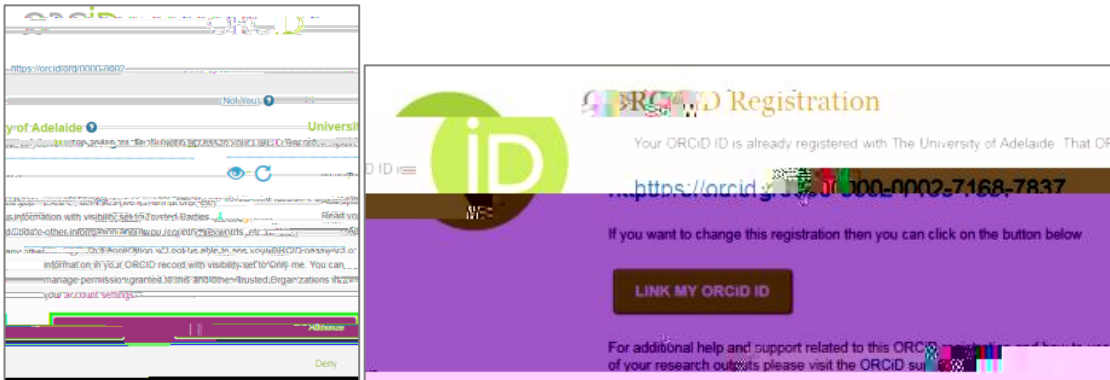

1. Navigate to your figshare profile by clicking on the small circle with your initials or photo, and selecting Profile.
2. Click on **CONNECT** next to the ORCiD field and **Add account**.

3. Select Authorize to link your ORCID with the University of Adelaide and a confirmation will appear with your new ORCID details.
