If you make your software available for others to use, you should apply a license to that software. A software license protects both software authors and users and enables you to establish copyright and specify how and in what circumstances your work can be reused by others.

Creative Commons licenses are not suitable for software and Creative Commons recommend that [free and open source software licenses](#) be used in their place. The ARDC [Research Software Rights Management Guide](#) outlines the different licenses available to help you make an informed choice.
